The Master's Program (CE) International Relations and Urban Policy is part of the Department Administration, Economics, Security, Politics. This program is a platform for cooperation and exchange between representatives of academia, administration, and NGOs/NPOs. Through the interaction of academic standards and close communication with decision-makers, options and alternatives for action are to be identified and scientifically supported. A particular concern of the program is the inclusion of cross-cultural perspectives in applied political science in the areas of international relations (with reference to the Global South), democracy and human rights, conflict studies, and urban policy.
